# Project overview



- The project proposal was submitted in the framework of the **ISFB/2017/AG/ESUR Call for proposals** in order “to support the improvement of border surveillance by enhancing cooperation between Member States in the framework of EUROSUR, including, whenever appropriate, cooperation with third countries”
- CERETAB aims to improve border surveillance by enhancing cooperation between two EU Member States, Greece and Cyprus, via the exchange of vital information on their sea borders, in common areas of interest.
- Specific Objective: to increase the situational awareness within the broad area defined by the Greek-Cypriot sea borders, through the development of a secure information exchange channel and the upgrading of the **Greek-Cypriot National Coordination Centers** cooperation, within the framework of the EUROSUR Regulation.

- The total budget is 1.023.990,00€, of which **972.790,50€**, or 95%, is the EU contribution.

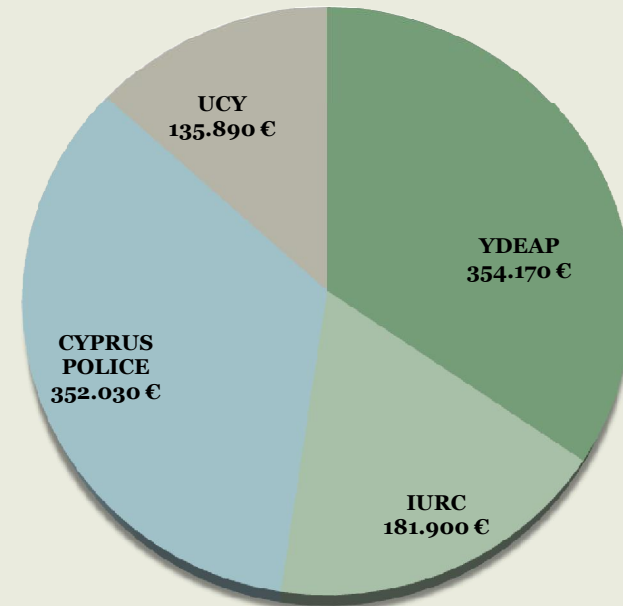

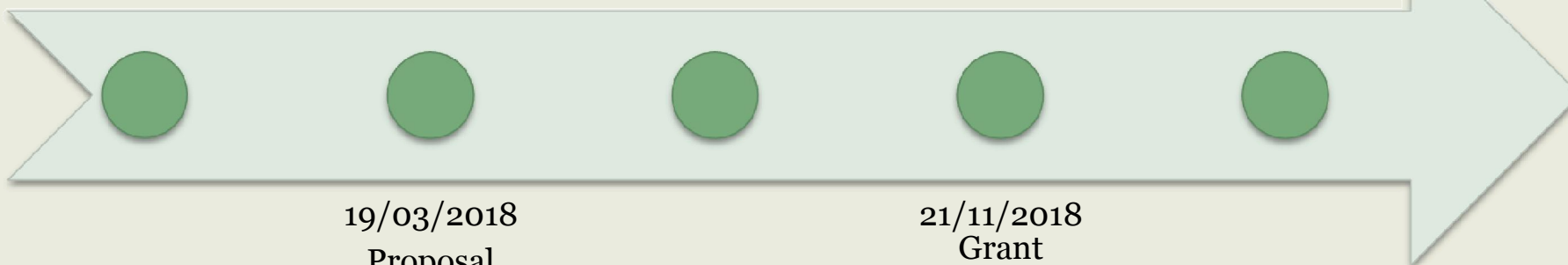
